

On February 8, 2023 The Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques King Salman bin Abdulaziz and HRH Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman directed the King Salman Humanitarian Aid and Relief Center to establish an air bridge to provide critical assistance to help the earthquake victims in Syria and Turkey.

The air bridge will provide medical, shelter, food and logistical assistance to alleviate the effects of the earthquake.

Saudi Arabia has also sent volunteers and medical and rescue teams to Turkey. On Feb. 9, the first group of volunteers from the Saudi relief effort arrived in Adana Airport, and the second Saudi relief plane arrived in Turkey carrying 98 tons of relief materials. The third, fourth, and fifth planes arrived on Feb. 10.

In coordination with Turkish authorities, urgent humanitarian relief including medical assistance, shelter, and rescue teams will be directed to northern Syria to assist with rescue operations.

As of Friday February 10th, The King Salman Humanitarian Aid and Relief Center's fundraising platform "Sahem" had raised more than \$60.000.000 from donations by

Saudi citizens.
